



Drivers' Briefing - Standing Start

- a) Track length: km 1,301
- b) Right-handers: 9
- c) Left-handers: 6
- d) Winners List: Online
- e) Track capacity for qualifications and races: 34 Karts
- f) Track capacity for free practice: 51 Karts
- g) Pole Position on the RIGHT side of the track
- h) Repair Zone: In front of the Mechanics Tribune inside the Service Park (Signposted)
- i) Number of Laps for the Race: See Programme

2. Behaviour on the track

- a) **Your behaviour on the track is subject to special attention and any anti-sports behaviour will be punished.**
- b) **Always check the schedule of the event and pay close attention to broadcasts.**
- c) **Anti-Covid 19 masks must be worn correctly at all times.**
- d) **It is forbidden to start the engines inside the Paddock (RDS Karting art. 11 letter F) after the sporting checks are concluded.**
- e) **You must pay particular attention when entering the racetrack at any time of the event, always give priority to the drivers already on the track.**
- f) **When you decide to return to the assistance park you must signal it in advance by raising your arm.**
- g) **Official Free Practice:** It is mandatory to install the Transponder.
- h) **Qualifying:** A 08-minute session is scheduled. If you stop in the repair area or return to the assistance park you cannot return on the racetrack.
- i) **Pre-grid:** Before the start of the race, all karts must be in the pre-grid. Only at the signal (Green Flag), you are allowed to start the engines.
- j) **Pole Position:** If you decide to change the starting side of the race, you must inform the Race Direction in writing and at least one hour before the start of the race.
- k) **Races:** During the formation lap do not stop and do not start rehearsals. Keep a moderate and steady speed until you reach your position on the grid. The Red Flag is in front of the grid. Until the Red Flag is in the centre of the grid no procedure will be initiated. Keep the front spoiler of your kart on the line of your starting box.
- l) When the Red Flag leaves the racetrack, the sequence of the Four Lights starts. Only when all lights are switched off, the race can begin. (Four Light Sequence: all lights on, all lights off).
- m) If you have mechanical problems that may cause danger (engine-off etc.), you must immediately signal it by raising your arms. The Starter will decide whether to grant a further formation lap by turning on flashing orange lights. The driver that caused the false start must begin the race in the last place. It does not matter if the sequence had not been started yet.
- n) If you run an early start, the penalty applied is +5 seconds to be added to your race time.



- o) Respect flags signals at all times, especially the Yellow flag. It is important for the safety of everyone on the racetrack.
- p) Respect the Blue flag signal: if waved, leave the race path immediately and facilitate overtaking.
- q) If you are involved in a race accident, please inform the staff of your physical condition as soon as possible. (Track Commissioners or Medical Staff)
- r) If your kart stops along the racetrack, you must immediately move away to a safe location. If you have a problem, report it to the nearest CP station. Once the kart is in a safe location, go to the CP station while always wearing the helmet and the jumpsuit.
- s) Give your full cooperation to the staff.
- t) Once the end of the race or the practice is signalled, you must return immediately to the closed park using the normal racetrack, without making stops and without receiving unauthorized outside help.
- u) During the Neutralization-SLOW Procedure you must maintain a very slow speed and stay in single file behind the race leader, who will set the pace. Overtaking is forbidden, only exception is if the leading driver has troubles.
- v) **Red Flag:** If displayed on the start/finish line, stop racing immediately and slow down dramatically. Finish the lap and follow the directions of the Race Direction.
- w) **Front spoiler:** If, after the checkered flag, it is not in the correct position you will receive a penalty of 5 seconds to add to your race time. Do not stop to fix the spoiler, if you do the penalty applied is the exclusion from the event and the payment of a fine of € 260.00.
- x) In the event of bad weather, to ensure compliance with the programme, races may be converted into timed-races (20 minutes). At the end of the twentieth minute, the race leader Will see the sign LAST LAP. After the following lap, the checkered flag will be waved.
- y) If, due to force majeure, the final races cannot be held, the placements of the Pre-finals will be valid for the championship ranking.
- z) Remember to perform all the weight and verification operations at the end of both Qualifying and races.
- aa) It is mandatory to take part in the award ceremony wearing your race suit.
- bb) The Race Direction is always available for any explanation regarding regulations and the running of the event.
